The Parable of the
Good Samaritan
Luke 10:25-37

Meditate on It:

“Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. Love him with all your strength and with all your mind. And love your neighbor as you love yourself.” ~Luke 10:27

Think About It:

This week begins with a lawyer trying to test Jesus with the question, “What must I do to receive eternal life?” Instead of falling into the trap, Jesus points him back to Scripture. What matters most is loving God fully and loving others as ourselves. It’s not about performance or appearances but about relationship and devotion.

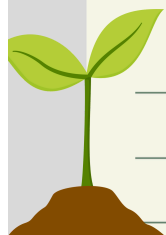
